

After the Budget is submitted to Monthly Meeting, we are to immediately mail pledge cards to members and make our appeal for funds. Then on the second Sunday in December, after the morning meeting for worship, a speaker would explain the Budget, and members invited into the Library to return pledge cards and obtain envelopes.

The Committee should meet again on Dec. 12 to consider how to reach those persons who have not pledged. Jesse A. Stanfield has promised to send out two weekly letters between now and the first of December, explaining the Budget.

It was decided to send the Pledge Cards to the entire Membership. Jesse A. Stanfield, Donald B. Van Hollen, and G. Cheston Carey were appointed a Committee to prepare a new type of Pledge Card, wherein a notation would be made that we suggest the following proportion be set aside:

- 50% for general expenses.
- 30% for Evangelistic & Church Extension work
- 20% for Budget of the Five Years Meeting.

The small white envelopes are to be placed in the benches for voluntary contributions from visitors, and the envelope system continued for use of those who desire to give in that manner.
