We decided that if such a letter was sent to the entire membership, Baltimore Monthly Meeting should also send a note of explanation therewith, that we are pledged to raise our quota, and that no concern need be felt that this Meeting will fall short of the designated amounts.

It was suggested to ask Alfred Townsend to set up a chart of the expenses of Baltimore Monthly Meeting, with comparisons of other years, and this is approved.

The next Meeting of the Finance Committee will be called by the Chairman when necessary.
