

At a meeting of Friends Library Committee held Baltimore Jan 21 1832 - Present Hugh Balderston Geo Williamson Joseph Townsend and Joseph King Jr. - Dan Cobb being absent. Jos Townsend was appointed Sec-
=retary pro. tem.

The proceedings of last meeting were read. The Committee continued reported they had made a selection and procured such books as appeared proper; they were loaded with the Librarian and the bill discharged by the Treasurer. The Committee were continued to attend further thereto as suitable books may offer.

Then adjourned to the next stated time at 5 o'clock in the evening at No 18 Baltimore Street

At a meeting of Friends Library Committee held 1st month 8th 1833. (The meeting for 12th mo. last having been postponed to this time)

The Friends continued in P^m last reported that an additional number of Books had been purchased and placed in the Library: They were continued to the service.

The Librarian informed this meeting that the Library has been so much enlarged as that

another Book Case was required. Joseph Townsend & Hugh Balderston were appointed to procure such an one as may be useful and authorized to call on the Treas^r for the amount of expense incurred. They are also requested to prepare a Catalogue of the Books contained in the Library and report to a future meeting.

Adjourned to the 3rd fifth day of 3rd mo next (21st) at the dwelling of Hugh Balderston at 7 o'clock in the evening.

At a meeting of Friends Library Comm^y. held 3rd mo 21st 1833. Present Joseph Townsend Hugh Balderston Jos King Jr (and) Daniel Cobb.

The Friends appointed to procure Books are continued.

The Committee to procure an additional Book Case and to prepare a Catalogue of the Books in the Library, inform that some attention has been given thereto, and that the Book Case is nearly completed.

Elisha W Brown our present Treasurer intending soon to embark for Europe to be absent a number of months, has paid over to Joseph King Jr. Eleven $\frac{42}{100}$ dollars (being the balance of funds in hand) and he is requested to serve as Treasurer to the Committee until the return of E W Brown.

Adjourned to the 3rd fifth day of 4th mo next (20) to meet at the dwelling of Daniel Cobb at 8 o'clock in the evening.
