

At a meeting of Friends Library Committee held 5th month 19. 1838 - present Joseph Townsend, Hugh Balderston, Joseph King Jr. and Elisha N. Browne

Our friend Daniel Cobb, formerly Clerk to this Committee, being deceased, Elisha N. Browne was appointed Clerk ~~for Term~~.

Joseph King Jr. informs that Insurance against Fire, as formerly directed, was effected on the Library, to the amount of \$500; with the Baltimore Fire Insurance Company, on 10th month 8. 1834 - and has since been continued

Hugh Balderston, and Elisha N. Browne were appointed to prepare and produce to next meeting, a suitable report to our next Monthly Meeting, in relation to the present situation of the Library

Joseph Townsend and Joseph King Jr. were appointed to examine and adjust the Treasurers account, and directed to report to our next meeting

Adjourned to meet at the dwelling of Joseph King Jr. on 4th day evening preceding our next Monthly Meeting at 8 o'clock

At a meeting of Friends Library Committee held 6th month 6. 1838 - present Joseph Townsend, Hugh Balderston, Joseph King Jr. and Elisha N. Browne

Friends appointed to prepare a report to our Monthly Meeting, produced the following copy of a report, which being corrected, was

approved - The Clerk was directed to sign the same on behalf of the Committee, and present it to the Monthly Meeting - viz -

To the Monthly Meeting of the Eastern and Western Districts, Baltimore

The Committee having charge of Friends Library report - That agreeably to the direction of the Monthly Meeting in the 9th month 1834, Insurance was effected, and is still continued on the Library to the amount of Five hundred dollars

No additions have been made to the Library since our last report, with the exception of a few volumes presented by a friend - and the only means at present at the disposal of the Committee for that purpose is \$10 ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ in the hands of our Treasurer, and the annual appropriation of twenty dollars due from the Monthly Meeting Stock in the 9th month last - These funds will enable the committee to make some additions during the present year, also pay our subscription to Friends Library

Since our last report two vacancies have occurred in the Committee, by the decease of our friends George Williamson and Daniel Cobb, which it is desirable should be filled
