At a meeting of the Library Committee at the Meeting House 3^d Mo. 3rd 1853. Eight members present. Francis J. King reported that nearly all the books directed to be purchased had been obtained. The Com^{tee} is continued to procure the remainder and call on the Treasurer for the Twenty dollars now on hand, and also propose additional books for the consideration of the meeting. The Men members of the Committee were requested to meet at the house of Rich^d. H. Thomas in regard to an application to the Monthly Meeting for liberty to erect a library and Committee Room adjoining the Meeting House. Then Concluded.

At a Meeting of the Library Committee held at the house of Rich^d. H. Thomas it was concluded to make the following application to the Monthly Meeting.

The Committee having charge of Friends Library request permission of the Monthly Meeting to build a Library & Committee Room on the North Side of the Meeting house, above the first, and to range with the Second Story. If the proposition meets the approbation of the Monthly Meeting they ask liberty to open a subscription to raise Eight hundred dollars for that purpose, the estimated cost of the room being \$700. & \$100. for furnishing it.
