

32 At a Special Meeting of Friends Library Com^{tee}. held at the Com^{tee}. Room 10 Mo 4 - 1855 present Six Members.

A proposition was made and adopted to employ the services of a female member of society to act as Librarian - to spend half an hour before, and half an hour after meeting on Fifth day of each week, or a longer time if required, in receiving and giving out books & keeping the Library in good order. The salary to be Eight dollars per Quarter.

Jacq E. King and Margaret Cheston are appointed to seek a suitable friend for the purpose and report to our next meeting.

In conformity with leave granted by the Monthly Meeting Jesse Tyson & Eliza B. Hayward are appointed to obtain annual subscriptions of one and two dollars from our members and others for the benefit of the Library and pay the same into the hands of the Treasurer.

It was proposed to offer to Friends Sewing Society the use of the Library room for their meetings which is united with. Then Concluded.

At a Meeting of the Library Com^{tee}. held 1 Mo 31. 1856 Eight Members present. The Com^{tee}. appointed to name a female member of society to act as Librarian, reported the name of Sophia Hopkins which is acceptable & she is accordingly appointed to the service at a salary of Eight dollars per Quarter - to devote half an hour at the close of each Fifth day Meeting in receiving and giving out books & keeping the Library in good order. Jesse Tyson reported that the Collecting Com^{tee}. had obtained from annual subscribers about the sum of forty dollars with the expectation of a larger amount. The Com^{tee}. is Continued to the service. Then Concluded.
