

At a meeting of Friends Association
for visiting the Penitentiary held
9th mo 23rd 1852. 14 Friends present.

The minutes of last mo having
been read the following report was
presented.

For several weeks after our
meeting in 6th mo last the prison was
visited, and the women were so orderly
and attentive to the instructions given
that it was with great reluctance we
felt obliged to discontinue our visits
on account of the absence of so many
from the city and the heat of the weather.
They appeared much subdued in feeling
and very seriously impressed by the
death of one of their companions Louisa
White, a colored girl who had been
long out of health and who suffered very
much during her last illness. She expressed
herself aware of her situation and we
were informed was often engaged in
prayer - but it is cause of great regret
that her case was not known by the
committee generally, as they might not
only have been enabled to administer
