The Visiting Committee offered the following report.

We have regularly visited the Prison since our last report with the exception of one First day when the inclemency of the weather prevented.

There has been a sufficient number of teachers, and the prisoners have generally

attended the School except when they were detained by sickness. Their behavior has been quiet and orderly when we were with them, and we have not heard any complaint of bad conduct during the week.

We were gratified with hearing of the manner in which they passed Thanksgiving day. They had holiday with permission to be in the school rooms, and the larger part of those who can read and spell occupied the time with their books. Such as were capable read aloud to the others, and instructed them in their books, and we thought they gave evidence on the following First day of having learned their lessons well. The Matron also testified to the same, as well as to their general good behavior. We were particularly pleased on hearing this, as they were not prompted to it by us, for we did not know they were to have holiday on that day. There have been no new admissions.

Through the intercession of the Warden Kitty Johns and Jane Parnell have been pardoned by the Governor. The former has been employed as nurse in the Wardens family, and her duties did not admit of her coming to school, we therefore do not know much about her. We have
