The committee named to take Maria Peck's case under care report that she has with the advice of Friends left her husband's house, and has been assisted in procuring a tolerably comfortable home. She has been furnished with employment which she seems anxious to procure and so far - appears desirous to lead a reformed life.

Julia Wilson, on behalf of the visiting of the visiting committee reported that

they had expended the ⁶⁷ sum of 15.89 for purchasing presents, having the rules printed &c. She is authorized to call upon the Treasurer for the amount.
