

Entertainment and Hospitality Committee.

This Committee shall consist of at least (6) six members. It shall provide for suitable refreshments for the meetings of the Association, decoration and arrangement of rooms where meetings are held, and shall endeavor to see that visitors and strangers are made welcome.

Standing Committees.

In addition to the aforesaid special committees, there shall be a standing committee of five or more members, in charge of each branch of work reporting to the Association. These Committees shall consist of volunteers, who shall give their names to the Secretary in October. It shall be understood, however, that the Executive Committee shall approve these Committees, and in case of sufficient members not volunteering to serve on any committee, they shall proceed to appoint others.

Election of Officers.

The officers and the two special committees of the Association shall be appointed by the Association at the meeting in the Spring for the ensuing year, a nomination committee having been appointed in the previous meeting to suggest names for appointment.

Meetings.

There shall be two regular business meetings held during the year, one in tenth month, and the other one at the close of the season's work. At the meeting in tenth month, the work for the year shall be considered, and the standing committees shall be formed. At the last meeting in the season, reports from all the committees shall be received and considered, and the officers and special committees for the ensuing year shall be appointed. In addition to the two regular business meetings, there shall be held in each of the intervening months a meeting for social and literary purposes. It shall be understood, however, that the Executive Committee shall have the authority to omit any of the meetings except the regular business meetings, if no programme can be arranged.
