CONSTITUTION OF THE Friends' Association for Christian Work.

AN Association is hereby formed for the purposes and under the Articles and Rules as follows, subject to change as hereinafter provided for.

ARTICLE I.

The name shall be "THE FRIENDS' ASSOCIATION FOR CHRISTIAN WORK OF BALTIMORE MONTHLY MEETING."

ARTICLE II.

The object of the Association shall be to encourage and take oversight of such of the work already organized, as the workers desire to place under its care,—to initiate and carry on any kind of Christian, Charitable or Mission Work which it may deem proper, within the limits of the Monthly Meeting,—to encourage the attendance of, and interest in, Bible Schools and Classes in the several meetings,—and to receive reports from the same as hereinafter provided. It may also receive reports from any other work carried on by its members, though not under its care.
