2nd answer

our Christian profession and to discourage the spirit
of detraction no apparent differences amongst us

3rd answer

educate their children and those under their care
in the several important principles of our

Christian testimony and to discourage their reading
Pious books and to encourage their frequent perusal
of the holy scriptures

4th answer

We believe friends support their testimony against
Spiritous Liquors agreeably to our discipline and to
avoid Taverns and places of disorder Moderation and
temperance in a good degree observed

5th answer

The Measures of the poor are inspected and some
relief afforded, No children requesting the aid of friends

6th answer

Friends maintain their testimony against
an intemperate ministry clear as far as appears, in the latter
part of the Query

7th answer

Friends appear careful to live within bounds
of their circumstances and to avoid involving themselves
in Business beyond their ability to manage and to
observe punctuality in complying with their engage-
ments

8th answer

Friends bear their testimony against slavery
and those of the African race under their care we believe
are suitably provided for some attention paid to their school
learning
