The Queries have been read, and the following answers
approved to be forwarded to the monthly meeting.

1st Answer All our meetings for Worship and Discipline
have been held; those on first day morning generally
attended by the most of our members, other meetings
often small, unbecoming behaviour guarded against
and the hour of meeting nearly observed by friends

2nd We believe there are many friends who are
concerned to maintain love towards each other -
becoming our Christian profession, and to discour-
age tale bearing and detraction. No differences
have come to our knowledge

3rd Some friends endeavour by example and precept
to educate their children, and those under their care
in plainness of speech, dress, and apparel, to
guard them against reading pernicious books, and
from the corrupt conversation of the world; and to
encourage the frequent reading of the Holy Scriptures.

4th Our testimony against distilled spirits is
maintained agreeably to Discipline and friend generally
avoid frequenting Taverns and places of diversion,
moderation and temperance mostly observed.

5th The necessities of the poor are inspected and relief
afforded. No children amongst us requiring aid

6th We believe friends are generally clear respecting
the several particulars of the Query

7th As far as appears, friends are concerned to comply with
the requisitions of the Query
