Many Friends maintain love towards
 each other becoming our christian profession, and are
 concerned to discourage tale bearing and detrac-
 tion, tho' deficiencies are apparent in these important
 particulars. When differences arise care has been

extended.

3rd Ans.

Some friends endeavour by example and precept to
 educate their children and those under their care in plainness
 of speech, deportment and apparel, to guard them against
 reading pernicious books, and from the corrupt conversation of
 the world, also to encourage the frequent perusal of the
 Holy Scriptures.

4th Ans.

Our testimony against distilled spirituous
 liquors, appears to be maintained, and we know of no
 breach of the latter part of this query.

5th Ans. No poor amongst us requiring aid, and
 care has been taken to comply with the latter part of
 the query.

6th Ans.

We believe friends are clear respecting the sev-
 eral particulars of the query.

7th Ans.

We believe friends are careful to comply with
 the requisitions of the query.

8th Ans.

Our testimony against slavery is maintained
 and we believe those of the African race in friends
 families are suitably provided for, and that care
 is taken to instruct them in useful learning.
