

And Encouraging One another, we desire to suggest to you some way in which this form of oversight may find helpful Expression.

1st It as should be the case, a loving interest is felt in all our Members, this interest will give rise to Earnest prayer for them when we are together.

2nd If any of our Members live at a distance from the Meeting to which they belong, Occasional letters from members of the Meeting, or Ministry & Oversight will help to keep alive and interest which Separation might otherwise lessen.

3rd In addition to the regular Meetings provided for in the Discipline Special Meetings may be held. As often as it may seem advisable at which Careful & prayerful Consideration may be given to individual Members of the Monthly Meeting. This will doubtless bring out Suggestions for helping those who are in trouble or need Encouragement. Particular Members will by this means be laid on our hearts, and as we desire it the Lord will open the way for us

to be of service to them.

4th Visits paid to Friends at their homes may be very helpful. These visits will be found of service when not a matter of formal appointment but those who go, should have themselves ready for religious ^{exercise} service if way opens for it. It is especially important that this duty should not be left to one or two, but that all members of the Meeting in Ministry & Oversight should share as far as possible. The words of Paul to The Ephesian Elders are very wisely applied to the members of this Meeting, in the discipline "Take heed to yourselves, and to all the flock over which the Holy Ghost hath made you Overseers, that ye feed the Church of God which he hath purchased with his own blood."
