The Association for Christian Work also provides a series of lectures on interesting and improving topics during the winter, after which refreshments are served, and there is an opportunity for social intercourse.

The Young Women's Fellowship still fills an important place in our meeting. It meets once a month during the winter for Bible Study and social intercourse having an average attendance of about 30. Most of whom are young women.

Meetings for the children of our meeting are also held devoted partly to recreation and partly to the consideration of such subjects as Peace, Friends Principles, Temperance &c &c. We feel that our 14 day school has been a most important factor in so far as the religious training of our young people is concerned. It has increased in average attendance

this year and a welcome is doing a good work. We feel that more of our young people should be sharing in the regular work of the meeting & giving definite evidence of their devotion of their lives to the Lord.

The young people at Light Street Meeting have been encouraged to take an active part in the 14 day school, and Christian Endeavor Society and have responded quite well. Efforts are now being made to enlist their active interest in other lines of work such as visiting the scholars or sick members the poor &c. Temperance work, tracts, and any other lines of Christian or Philanthropic work that may suggest themselves. The Pastoral Committee have held one conference with the young people and a committee have been appointed, and another conference has been arranged for. The meeting then proceeded to consider the spiritual condition of our congregation.
