The Committee of the Monthly meeting having the care of the Firstday evening meetings has been arranging a series of addresses on special topics under the general heading, "The Great Book and its Message", and the result has been encouraging. There has not been a great increase of attendance, but there has been some gain, and the interest has been good. Some increase of interest and attendance of the Bible School is also manifest; and a committee of the body is now assisting the Pastoral Committee of that congregation to work out plans which it is hoped will increase the interest of the members generally. The Firstday morning meeting continues to be small.

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Eutaw St.

We do not think there has been any increase of attendance at the Firstday morning meeting, and possibly there has been some falling off. The Fifth day meetings are smaller than heretofore, but we believe the spiritual life in all our meetings is good, and the ministry helpful.

We would suggest to the Quarterly Meeting on Ministry and Oversight that arrangements be made, in such manner as seems best, for the presentation of a special topic bearing upon our church life, for discussion at the meeting in 6th month.
