Pastoral
Plan.

The Committee appointed to arrange for assignment of names of Friends to members of this meeting presented the following statement of the plan proposed, which was adopted.

"The Pastoral Committee of Baltimore Monthly Meeting, wishing to manifest that watchful care, over, and warm interest in, the members of Eutaw St. congregation which the welfare of the meeting demands asks each of its active members to become especially interested in the friends named on the list furnished to each. It is not intended that care for others shall be lessened, or that the pastoral oversight of those on each one's list shall be confined to those to whom it is given, but rather that in every case some one shall be responsible for actual conditions.

In carrying out the plan we suggest that it would be well to be informed on the following points:

Whenever there is any sickness or cause for anxiety.

Whether there is any ground for feeling that Friends do not show sufficient attention socially.

If absence from meeting is noticed whether sufficient cause exists.

Consider carefully whether service in the meeting can be given to ones not actively engaged.
