To Baltimore Quarterly Meeting on Ministry and Oversight held at Hagerwell, Virginia, 6th Mo. 10th 1916.

As the neighborhood meetings were such a factor in the preparations for the recent Campaign conducted by William Sunday the Committee thought such meetings might be helpful to our churches and accordingly planned to hold them at the homes of Friends when they were opened. Two have been held with profit.

Through the concern of one of our members a special prayer meeting for the work of the Meeting and an increase in the spiritual life, was appointed to be held at the close of first-day morning meeting on 4th Mo. 16th. With a few exceptions the entire congregation attended and the meeting was inspiring and helpful.
