CHARACTERISTICS OF THE WORK.

1. It is not a church.
2. It is not an organism.
3. The work has been hitherto a series of separate and independent units, having as their purpose the betterment and salvation of the people.
4. Hitherto there has been no co-ordinating and unifying center. For example, the avowed object of the work has not been the establishment of a Friends' Meeting.
5. The persons who have been greatly helped have invariably moved to better localities or joined neighboring churches.
6. There is no young people's department and no connecting link between the Bible School and the Church.
7. The work as at present conducted does not guarantee continuity.
8. In my opinion the large room downstairs is bare, uninviting, too large, and unsuitably furnished for a gospel service.
9. Any attempts at co-ordination must be a joint action voluntarily undertaken by the heads of all the departments.

RECOMMENDATIONS.

I would recommend:

1. That before the opening of the fall work the heads of the various departments confer to consider whether any steps should be taken, and if so, what, to co-ordinate the work.
2. I would recommend that at the opening of the fall work a united social be held at which departments be represented.
3. I request that before any disposition be made of the benches now in use at Eulaw Street the Trustees and the Pastoral Committee consider the advisability of installing them at Light Street.
