

11th Mo. 25-1918

At a meeting of the Pastoral Committee and Meeting on Ministry and Oversight, held 11th Mo. 25th, 1918, 9 members were present.

After a time of devotion, the Minutes were read and approved.

Reports of the three Committees previously appointed, were called for.

Report of for the Committee to consider means of co-operating with the Bible Schools

"The Committee appointed to consider means of co-operating with the Bible Schools, have consulted with the Superintendent of Enlaw St. Bible School and have given consideration to the matter referred to them, and are united in proposing the following two suggestions

1st. That the Pastoral Committee shall send a written invitation to each member of the Meeting, who is not regularly attending the Bible Classes, asking for such attendance.

2nd. That the Pastoral Committee arrange each year for a series of four or five talks or lessons with members of the Bible Schools above twelve years of age, which shall bring to their attention and suggest to them the advisability of becoming active members of the meeting.

This report was acceptable to the Meeting, and the Committee was further directed to prepare a draft of such letter as it suggested and present same at our next meeting.

No action was taken on the 2nd suggestion of the Committee.

Margaret T. Carey made a verbal report for the Committee on Associate Members, and A. V. Horneberg (reported)

some progress made by the Committee on Members and Attenders. The last two Committees were asked to report in writing to our next meeting.

Application An application for membership was received from Joseph J. Merrifield. John C. Thomas and A. Morris Carey were appointed to visit the applicant and with our approval, report to the Monthly Meeting, if way opens.

Co-operating Members The Meeting directed that the Monthly Meeting be asked to appoint Lucy M. Thrullon and George Wood to co-operate with this meeting in its Pastoral duties.

It was decided to resume the former practice of sending notices to members of the Pastoral Committee and Meeting on Ministry and Oversight.

Time for holding our meetings. The time for holding these meetings shall be the Wednesday evenings - precisely the last Wednesday in the month - at 8 P.M.

The need for having some member or members of the Pastoral Committee sit near the door during First Day morning meeting - who would be definitely responsible for the seeing of welcoming strangers, was considered. The matter was referred to the Overseers with request to report at our next meeting.

After a devotional time meeting adjourned.
