An application for Associate membership for their minor child Helen T. Barnett, aged 11 years, was received from Andrew Bryngett and Sarah S. Barnett - which was acceptable to the meeting and directed to be forwarded to the Clerks of the Monthly Meeting.

The letters from Non-residents, which had been referred to the Special Committee on Non-resident members - were returned to the Pastoral Committee with the suggestion that they be referred to the Overseers, as their Committee was appointed to meet circumstances different from those affecting this list.

After discussion the Clerks were directed to forward the letters to the Monthly Meeting for consideration and action. The Committee on Non-residents was released at its own request.

The feasibility of holding our mid-week meeting for worship down town during May and part of June - was considered. It was reported that a room in the Bible House would be available for such purpose if desired. The Clerks were instructed to recommend the consideration of this subject to the Monthly Meeting. After a time of silence meeting adjourned.
