An application for membership was received from James Hunter, which was approved by the Committee and upon report from James Carey Jr. and A. Viola Horstberg who were appointed to talk with him the application was to be forwarded to the Monthly Meeting.

Lewis C. Moon then presented some of the plans he had in mind for the correlation of the departments of work - looking toward less duplication of effort and greater efficiency. He spoke of the relation of the Meeting to the Community and made some suggestions
