A Committee to cooperate with the Religious Education Committee of the Monthly Meeting, to plan and carry out this canvass, was appointed as follows; Anna Thomas, James Carey Jr, John R Cary.

8. The matter of the time of holding the mid-week meeting was brought to the attention of this Committee. After discussion it was decided to bring the matter to the attention of the Monthly Meeting, with the suggestion that whatever plan is adopted it shall be made to meet the convenience of the ladies who meet here for sewing.
9. The matter of visiting was discussed at this time. It is felt that the visiting in the meeting should be more reciprocal, and that members be urged to return visits made to them by other members of the Meeting. The Secretary is asked to explain to the members of the Meeting at an appropriate time, so that all members may have this in mind. It is also suggested that the Chairman of this Committee write a brief explanation of this idea of visiting and publish it in the Interchange.
