

October 22nd 1925

A regular meeting of the Pastoral Committee was held October 22nd 1925 with 14 members present.

In the absence of the Secretary the Chairman acted for the day.

After reading a portion of the Scriptures and a period of devotion the minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Two of the Representatives attended the Quarterly Mtg held at Dorlingham and two were unavoidably absent on account of motor trouble. Anna B. Thomas for the Representatives reported and interesting session of the Quarterly Mtg and spoke of a very helpful message given at the First Day morning meeting.

A Certificate of removal of Anna B. and Gertrude King and recommendation to the Fellowship of Home and Friends Meeting was received from Brown Memorial Presbyterian Church. It was read & directed to be forwarded to the Monthly Meeting.

The Chairman was authorized to ask the Finance Committee for the ensuing year the sum of \$50.⁰⁰ plus the amount needed by the Overseers.

The question of how best to make contacts with those in the outlying meeting sections of the City who might be interested in the Worker's message was considered and interested friends were encouraged to take such steps to communicate with them as may

may open.

The subject of more definite propositions for progressive work was brought before the meeting and in the discussion of this, it was felt that some of the members do not realize the work the Meeting is doing and it was the sense of the Meeting that the Monthly Meeting's Executive Committee be asked to consider the question of how best to acquaint the membership with the activities of the Meeting.

James Thomas Chappell was present and welcomed the cooperation of this Committee in developing the spiritual life of the young people of Light Street Meeting.
