of 25 to 30 in 1925, and of 20 to 25 in 1926 and
of 15 to 20 in 1927.

We think that this points undoubtedly to the
absolute need of a change in the conduct of
the mtgs. The pastoral work is being ably
& efficiently attended to, & the members love
& respect the official members of the Mtg.,
and we believe that if the religious mtgs
were conducted more nearly along the lines
of Quaker testimonies, giving opportunity
for more variety & freshness & bible truth &
personal testimony briefly stated, it would
be distinctly different from other churches
& have an attraction for many who feel
the life & power of such a Mtg under the
guidance of the Holy Spirit.

We feel more convinced than ever that a one-
man ministry is not the best type of
ministry, ^{for a Friends Mtg} & we recommend the appoint-
ment of a Committee ^{5 or 6} of ^{on M. & C.} Salt Local Mtg. ^{of}
whom J. Thos. Chappell & Mrs. J. Chappell might
be members, to have charge of Light ^{mtg} & see
that it be conducted in accordance
with ^{the} principles above stated.
