

March 21st 1929

A Meeting of Ministry and Oversight and the Pastoral Committee was held at Hornewood Meeting House, March 21st 1929. Eleven members were present. After a devotional period the Minutes of the Meeting held Feb. 21st 1929, and of the Special Meeting held Feb. 28th 1929 were read, and with a slight correction, were approved.
