Whitely was felt to be very helpful and successful, and it was decided that a letter be sent from the Pastoral Committee to the Home Mission Board of the Five Years Meeting, expressing our appreciation of his visit and services.

The death of Benjamin Lewis, a former member of Baltimore Yearly Meeting, which occurred in Cincinnati Ohio, was spoken of, and the Recording Clerk was requested to write a letter to the family expressing the sympathy of the Pastoral Committee.

The Committee on Associate Members reported that the letters had been sent to the young people attending colleges and schools.

Thomas W. G. Clark, Eugenia H. Parker and Mary E. Whitney were appointed a nominating Committee to name officers to serve the Pastoral Committee and the meeting of Ministry and Oversight for the ensuing year.

The subject of how was the best way of approaching the strangers who attend our First Day Morning Meeting was discussed, and it was decided that an invitation should be given from the Platform to all strangers in the meeting to put their name and address on cards that would be provided for that purpose, if they felt like doing so.
