

A Meeting of Ministry and Oversight and the Pastoral Committee was held at Homewood Meeting House on Thursday December 19-1929. Thirteen members were present.

After a time of devotion the Minutes of the last meeting were read and accepted.

The report of the Representatives to the Quarterly Meeting of Ministry and Oversight held at Darlington, which was deferred from last meeting, was made at this time. All but one of the Representatives attended the Quarterly Meeting of Ministry and Oversight.

The following change in the discipline, which was adopted by the last Yearly Meeting, was read

"The Duties and Membership of the Ministry and Oversight may be the same as those of the Pastoral Committee". This Meeting adopted this minute, and hereafter the duties and Membership of Ministry and Oversight and the Pastoral Committee will be the same. Applications for membership were received from John David Elder and Katharine Macklin Elder - also an application for Associate Membership from John David Elder and Katharine Macklin Elder for their son John David Elder Jr. A letter releasing John David Elder from membership in the Reformed Protestant Dutch Church of the City of New York was read. Margaret T. Carey and James Carey Jr. had been asked to visit them, and their report having been favorable, the Applications were directed to be forwarded to the Monthly Meeting with the approval of the Pastoral Committee. A letter was read from the Federation of Churches stating that January 19th is proposed as the day for general Interdenominational Exchange of Pulpits, inviting our Meeting to participate in the Movement.

It was decided that a reply be sent saying that our Meeting would accept the invitation to participate in the Movement.

The following Representatives were appointed to attend the Quarterly Meeting of Ministry and Oversight to be held in Washington, D. C.

January 11th 1930. Margaret T. Carey, A. Morris Carey - Lindley L. Clark and Mary E. Carey. The Recording Clerk was directed to inform the Monthly Meeting that there are two vacancies in the Eldership - occurred by the deaths of John R. Carey and Richard J. White. If the Monthly Meeting takes any action, we appoint A. Morris Carey and Mary E. Carey to cooperate with the Committee that the Monthly Meeting appoints.

The Committee to occasionally invite Friends to attend our First Day Morning Meeting reported that Alfred Garrett is expecting to attend the Meeting on December 29th.
