

belief in the necessity of being baptised by the Holy Ghost, and of constant communion through Him with the Father and the Son, for Christian growth: and, understanding the nature of the Gospel dispensation to be essentially spiritual, we have agreed, as a Society, to disuse the outward symbols.

Those that have been Christians for over six months shall be considered full members: - those that have been converted within that time shall be considered associate members till the six months have passed - but shall be entitled in the mean time to all the privileges of full members.

At a regular Monthly Meeting of Friends Federal Hill Mission held March 6th 1879. present members & asst. members. It was decided to appoint a standing Committee on Membership, to receive applications, & to visit the applicants, & to determine whether it be advisable to bring their names before the Monthly Meeting. The following persons were appointed on this Committee. viz. John C. Thomas, Mina Marshall Aaron Wall Eliza Brown, Rich^d. H. Thomas. Applications from Mrs Bredour, & Champion Harrison, which were referred to this committee to report to our next meeting. Otto Schroeder was admitted as a full member. It was decided to appoint a committee of 6, two of them to be changed each month, whose duty it shall be to visit the members as often as may seem desirable, especially such as may be absent twice in succession from our meetings. The following persons were appointed on this Committee. viz.
