In view of the small receipts towards the Expense Fund, Gottlieb Frey, W^m Schelhaus, Geo. C. Wise Jr. & Louisa Sanders were appointed to consider whether some change in the mode of receiving contributions may not be desirable, & to report to next meeting.

The Treasurer of Relief Fund sent word that prolonged sickness in her family the past month, has prevented attention to her duties as Treasurer.

The Treasurer of Foreign Mission Fund reported that the receipts from the First day school the past month amounted to \$4.³⁵ which with the amt on hand

at last report, \$4.⁵², makes a total of \$8.⁸⁷ which is all in the hands of the Treasurer, W^m Schelhaus.

The Secretary of the First day school reported an average attendance of 4 officers, 7 teachers & 61 scholars in large room & Bible class, & 49 in primary department, making a total of 121. The Supt. reported that the usual Christmas entertainment was held on the 29th ult & was very satisfactory, considering the amount of sickness & the wet weather.

The chairman of Home Mission Com^t reported 1 cottage prayer meeting held, with an attendance of 8. The holiday season & the prevalence of the gripe has prevented the holding of any more. Gottlieb Frey, Harry Muller & Anna Della were appointed a committee to audit the accounts of the different Funds collected regularly from our members.

Much concern was expressed because of the apparent lack of interest of many of our members & the Oversight Com^t was authorized to hold a series of meetings as soon as some outside help can be obtained.
