BE IT RESOLVED that the Maryland Branch

Peace and Freedom hereby deeply regrets
the lynching of a prisoner by a mob in
Salisbury, Maryland, on December 4, 1931,
and heartily commends the stand which
your Excellency has taken in regard to
bringing to justice those responsible
for this act of violence in contempt of
the laws of the State.
