The hot-bed of the insurrection apparently is throughout the Cambridge and Salisbury sections of the shore, although bitter resentment is being openly expressed in practically every part of the nine-county-area.

Although business houses, generally, recognize the fact that Baltimore industries are in no way responsible for the expressions of the Sunpapers, thousands of dollars worth of retail and wholesale business which formerly went to Baltimore regularly, now is going to either Wilmington or Philadelphia.
